As you are probably aware ,plans have been submitted for the above, and as Mirfield residents would like to put forward our objections to this as follows.

This development is proposed for siting ,fronting Mirfield High St.and Trinity St, which is highly unsuitable for the following reasons.

- 1 This corner building fronts a highway box allowing residents to gain access to Trinity Street And should be kept clear at all times.
- 2 Trinity St itself is a very narrow street allowing only a single flow of traffic with permit parking on one side thus narrowing it even further.
- 3 Mirfield Fire Station is only a few yards away on the Hight St. which obviously has to be kept clear at all times,and worries are that this access will be impinged upon by customers either collecting pizzas, delivery bikes or vehicles,as no parking is allowed Either side of this proposed development.
- 4 This proposal appears not take into consideration, the wellbeing of the residents of Trinity St. from the point of view of access, increased traffic ,noise,smells and constant activity from 11 a.m to 11 p.m seven days a week.
- 5 Finally, the proposal is obviously not considering that apart the from residents in Trinity, Trinity Chapel has a number of daytime activities which attracts large groups of Young and older people throughout the week and of course parishoners who wish to worship,and who would use the Chapels private car park There is also a Scout hut which not only caters for the Scouts and Cubs but also a cycle club ensuring that the Scout hut is in constant use. Adding to this are a number of small children resident in the Streets properties, who would be put at risk with traffic endeavouring to gain access reversing onto the main road and the obvious number of E.bilke delivery people who would naturally be employed.
