Deliveries for fitting out will be a problem plus the workmen in their vans. It's a very narrow street and there are more houses than you think. Where will they all park and turn round?

We on a daily basis have problems getting out getting in and out on to Huddersfield Road. There's poor visibility and people walk across in front of our cars lorries. Cars waiting for the lights to change block the exit. The keep clear space is ignored. Turning right is a nightmare.

Mothers and pushchairs with children walk across and down the side going to church for mother and toddler meetings. There's all sorts going on at the church, ie Weight Watchers and Warm Space. It's not just services. Cars and parking can be a problem for residents anyway, let alone with a big pizza takeaway.

Parents and Children walk down Trinity Street to the Scouts, sometimes in their cars.

Buses use the layby 7 Days a week. Plus Rail replacement buses until 2027.
