Unfortunately i must object to this planning application on the following grounds, 1- Noise - with the site being very close to the railway line, as well as its proximity to John Williams Street which is inundated with Nuisance modified cars/vehicles aswell as well established hospitality venues near by, i believe the site to be unfit for residential use. 2- Safety - With the proximity to Wood street, and the outdoor market i believe the location would be unsafe on a late evening due to drunken people, possible crime and disorder and very frequent beggars. Also given the close proximity to an adult entertainment venue i believe this will negatively affect the wellbeing of residents due to the frequent loitering of The venues patrons. especially for those of the ground and lower level flats. 3- refuge - i read refuge is to be stored inside the premises but there is no specified area for these bins, with access being the second floor up (ground level) on the plans, can we ensure the bins stay inside due to an already ongoing issue of vermin on wood street 4 - given some of the flats are ground level or below i believe privacy will be an issue for occupants as people would be able to see straight into their premises just by walking past with no buffer between the window and street e.g garden.
