Good afternoon I have just spoken to your colleague on the phone and has advised I send an email .

I am working for a developer called taylor Wimpey . The site above is a historic site with a large retaining wall covering 20 + gardens . The whole retaining wall has failed and has now been condemned . There is major works to make the area safe and reinstate the wall and foundations. We have been asked to remove all vegetation ,bushes and small trees within the works areas -pictures below . I have carried out the check and noticed we are working in a conservation area. T I am more than happy to meet you on site early next week ?

What the construction contractor needs in a nut shell is working room from the top of the banking ,I believe around 9 silver birch trees will need to be removed and then all trees ,veg and bushes on the banking area . As soon as we have carried out our works they will then start to dig out the walls and banking .

We will also plan to reinstate all felled trees .so we will be conducting a tree survey to we can replace what was taken out .
