

The nature and form of the heritage asset

Finthorpe is a Grade II listed building located in Almondbury, Kirklees, West Yorkshire. This mid-18th-century structure features an ashlar front, a pitched stone slate roof, and a modillion eaves cornice. The building is notable for its five ranges of sashes with glazing bars and a central first-floor window with a moulded frame. The door has a fanlight and later glazing bars in a moulded frame with a pulvinated frieze and moulded cornice. The rear has 2 ranges of bipartite sashes with glazing bars and 1st floor Venetian window with Gothic glazing bars.

The proposed works

Replace existing windows to a listed building

The works comprise of replacing the existing ill repaired and rotten windows sympathetic to their original appearance, whilst improving their thermal performance. New timber windows having mouldings and section profile to match the existing. Paint finished to a heritage colour. Drawings produced to confirm the existing and new sections.

The proposed replacement windows will have negligible impact on the assets character due to the manufacture being sympathetically to the period of this property.

current windows suffer from rot and lack and draft exclusion. The new in keeping handcrafted timber windows will bring the property back to its original character. Whilst improving the living space, light and ventilation for its current custodians.
