<p>I am writing to you as a regular driver who often travels along Birkby Lodge Road to voice my strong support for the removal of the pillars situated at number 50.</p> <p>From my experience, these pillars present serious difficulties for motorists trying to enter or exit the driveway nearby. The limited space often forces vehicles to stop awkwardly, at times partially obstructing the road. This not only interrupts the steady movement of traffic but also poses clear safety risks for both drivers and pedestrians.</p> <p>I have personally encountered several near-misses, particularly when vehicles are forced to reverse at odd angles or come to sudden stops while manoeuvring around the pillars. These issues become even more dangerous during busy periods or when roadside parking further narrows the space.</p> <p>Taking down the pillars would greatly improve access to the driveway, increase visibility, and significantly enhance the safety and efficiency of traffic along this stretch.</p> <p>Thank you for considering this issue. I strongly encourage the council to proceed with the proposed removal.</p>
