<p>As a daily user with my young child and toddler of the PROW I am quite concerned about the removal of the stone pillars. The PROW is a beautiful way for many children to enjoy walking to school and nature safely. The removal of these stone pillars would mean cars entering at higher speeds than they already do, which I have already seen with near misses of children and family's we walk to school with together. The work already done on the side of the PROW should be assessed before a decision is made as it's extremely shoddy with plastic fence wrap left to fall away and the finish of the cement in the wall quite frankly a 5 year old could of done a better job.</p> <p>This does not give me confidence that any further work would be carried out sympathetically.</p> <p>Furthermore there is a concern that the removal of these pillars could impact the stability of the adjoining structures resulting in potential collapse leading to death or serious injury of PROW users.</p>
