<p>The use of the PROW as a drive has already led to several near misses due to it being extensively used as a route for school children and the removal of these perceived 'obstacles' would only increase the potential speed of vehicles entering the PROW. There are also concerns regarding ground and adjoined structure stability by the removal of these pillars. If done poorly there is a high probability of water ingress to the foundations of the wall resulting in its potential collapse which poses a risk to life should it fail. Additionally, such works would result in the PROW being unusable during the removal of the pillars. Another aspect for consideration is who will benefit from the financial gains of the sale of the pillars, as if it is the residents rather than the council or community, this is unacceptable. The works carried out at and around the property have already been extensive with excessive noise, removal of trees and possible impact to protected bats that reside in the adjoining community gardens.</p>
