My name is 51, The Combs Thornhill, Dewsbury wf12 0lq I need to oppose the building of 34 dwellings to be erected at the bottom of Hall Lane, it's not the amount of houses that's been proposed it's the fact the access to this site is very restricted because at the top of Hall Lane even now when people turn left onto church lane it can't be done without crossing the double white lines in the centre of the road on a completely blind bend there have been many accidents and near misses at this point, only yesterday there was a three car pile up and one of the cars was a right off, when the old hostel was being demolished the low loader couldn't access the site because of the road being too narrow so all the bulldozers and diggers were unloaded in front of my house which made my house vibrate to the point of my internal doors were all shaking, if these houses were built that could mean that there could be 60/70 cars of which half might try to turn left onto church lane which would be a disaster, I can't believe that someone from the planning department at Kirklees would agree to this without proper access, I know there have been many objections from my neighbours to this proposal and rightly so, I think I am correct in saying that planning has been refused before after highways were involved and they could see it would be a massive problem, could someone from the planning department please take another look at this as it's completely wrong to allow this outrageous proposal, please see attached picture of one of the three cars involved in the accident yesterday
