Faiza,

We have noticed a comment on the Planning System regrading the footpath that spans/traverses across the owners plot. We would like to make the following comments:

1. The footpath is not being currently followed onto our plot as the stile at the bottom of the garden is impossible to use due to it being overgrown, steep and uneven (not our land). Also, at the very bottom where it meets the road there are

no signs stating it's a footpath, to be able to get up and down from there, there is a wall with no steps to access. Therefore, people are now using / going down the track to rear of the property which then leads on the main access road.

2. When the path has been accessed and not blocked off to the public due the overgrown grass etc, people are let their dogs run around out of control scaring the livestock we keep, plus not cleaning up after their dogs.
3. Also, various footpath maps do not even show it as being a footpath.
