With reference to our telephone conversation, please find attached copy our objection letters in 2001 and 2008.

The railway cutting was backfilled in 2001/2. S Lok bought the land and proposed to build dwellings on this land. We raised objection and restricted the number of dwellings.

The remaining land was later bought by a new developer who packaged the houses with a doctor/clinic building. We raised objection again in 2008 but was not upheld. (A petition was raised for the clinic in local mosques in support of clinic.)

The owner MR ISMAIL has sold individual plots to individuals to build their own dwelling. Mr I Ismail is the person who has now put in his application. (Not the same Ismail).

Our objections still remain same but we have additional concerns:

1. The retaining wall construction involve deep excavations which have carried out unsupported and left open over a year. This has resulted partial collapse of the earth.
2. Excavation work over period of years has left my garden fence wall in poor state of repair.
3. Moreover it is no longer a fence wall but a parapet wall which needs to be designed by structural engineer. A steep 45 degree downward slope(4.2m) and a 3 metres retaining wall is a hazard. This needs to be included in the developers scope of works.

Finally, I attach photos to illustrate and support the various points raised.
