This is not a Listed Building and is not within a Conservation Area. The war memorial is identified as the Memorial Recreational Ground but the building is not a memorial building itself and is not classed as a heritage asset. The proposals do not impact on the original use of the land as recreational ground. The alterations to the building support the use of the land.
