Subject: Planning Application 2025/90956

I wish to register an objection to the proposed redevelopment of Moorlands Cricket Club clubhouse on the grounds of inadequate parking facilities within the Club's grounds. Such is the case that when a function takes place within the club facilities – indoor or out – cars are parked both sides of the Huddersfield road reducing the available width for traffic to one lane. The sight line out of the main entrance and also out of Hurst Lane is poor and so creates a dangerous situation.

Not only is the main road congested but Hurst Lane also with, on occasions, vehicles parked down both sides of the Lane and sometimes the full length of the Lane. In the last 12 months there were two incidents of Hurst Lane residents being unable to access/egress their properties due to inconsiderate parking. Furthermore, there is always a risk of emergency vehicles being impeded. Hurst Lane was never meant to be a 'carpark' and not being a through road every non-resident vehicle has to execute a three-point turn to egress. On a soft surface it results in serious deterioration.
