<p>I wish to raise an objection to this proposal. This is a residential area, not an area of commercial enterprises. As stated in my previous objection to the last submission, traffic movements and parking issues have not been addressed by this application. This is an estate built as a cul de sac with one road that serves traffic passing both in and out; the estate road is very narrow and number 17 Far View Crescent is situated at one of the narrowest points.</p> <p>The area itself is does not have readily available facilities for children. Crucially there is no public transport nearby, there are no recreation facilities or open spaces nearby and the local schools are some distance away , necessitating the use of a car - or in the case of the most vulnerable, Kirklees school transport possibly a minibus?</p> <p>Now we come to number 17 - this was billed as a large family home, advertised for a price that was impossible to achieve. It has parlous little outdoor space, meaning little opportunity for play, it enjoys little privacy for the occupants as so much glass has been used in construction. At the rear is a first floor balcony, have safeguarding issues and health and safety legislation been considered? Accessibility both outside and inside is another issue.</p> <p>I could go on - I sincerely hope that the comments submitted by myself and my neighbours will be given serious consideration before a decision is made.</p>
