| <p>I formally object to the revised planning application regarding the proposed change of use of 17 Far View Crescent.</p> <p>Once again, the applicant is attempting to push through a conversion of this property into a children's home. Despite reducing the number of children from four to three, the issues raised in previous objections remain entirely unresolved. The concerns about increased traffic, congestion on our quiet residential street, and the lack of suitable amenities for children are still valid.</p> <p>Over many years, there have been repeated attempts to change the use of this property from residential to commercial, and each time these efforts have been met with strong objection because the same problems persist. The location, situated in a cul-de-sac, is simply not appropriate for such a development.</p> <p>The latest proposal introduces shift changeover times at 07:30 and 23:00, which will result in increased noise and vehicle activity during times that are usually peaceful. This represents a further disruption to the character and tranquillity of our neighbourhood.</p> <p>I also question the economic viability of operating a facility for only three children. It raises the concern that this is simply a tactical move to gain approval, with a future request to increase capacity likely to follow once permission is granted.</p> <p>In my opinion, the repeated submission of slightly amended applications appears to be a deliberate attempt to wear down local opposition, hoping that fewer residents will engage each time. This strategy shows little regard for the community's voice and undermines the planning process.</p> <p>I strongly object to this application and fully support all previous objections submitted in response to this and earlier versions.</p> | |
