Subject: Objection to Unapproved Retaining Wall and Fence Construction on Quarry Road

Dear Farzana Tabasum,

I am writing to you today to raise a formal objection regarding the proposed construction of a retaining wall and fence on Quarry Road, adjacent to Westgate Road. I have been given the plans for this project, which detail a structure with a total height of 4.65 meters, consisting of a 2.65-meter retaining wall and a 2-meter fence on top. The structure is planned to be built 7 meters from my boundary wall and 11 meters from my house.

I have observed that the main contractor, Strata, appears to be moving forward with the project as if planning permission has been granted. However, upon checking the planning portal, I have found that planning applications 2025-44-92254-E and 2025-44-90964-E have not yet been approved.

Additionally, I can confirm that the residents of Clare Road have not been consulted on a structure of this significant size, which would be in clear contravention of the Highways Act 1980. The proposed wall's height and proximity to the main road directly impacts public safety and requires proper consultation and approval.

I urge you to halt all work on this project until the planning applications have been properly reviewed and approved, and the required community consultations have been conducted in accordance with planning regulations.
