Thank you for your letter and plan received on 22-Apr-2025 regarding the above.

I am only able to consider non-material amendments to plans approved under a previous planning permission which are minor and do not materially change the appearance or character of the previously publicised scheme. The proposed alterations to the approved plans extend beyond this and hence I am unable to accept them. A new application will be required which will be subject to a further round of publicity and consultation.

On the basis of the above, the proposed change would not be acceptable under the non-material amendment procedure and as such is recommended for refusal. The applicant may wish to apply for a Section 73 condition to vary conditions 2 & 4 of permission reference 2022/90403.

However, please be aware that these comments are offered without prejudice to the future decision of this Authority on the formal planning application.
