

To Whom It May Concern,

I am writing to formally request permission to carry out necessary tree works within the boundary of my property located in the conservation area of Edgerton, Huddersfield. The trees on my property do not have a Tree Preservation Order (TPO) placed upon them, and I believe these works are essential for several reasons:

1. Overgrown Conifer Trees (Trees A on the attached Tree Location Drawing):

The majority of the trees are conifers that have significantly outgrown their space. We intend to trim them to a manageable height. This is important because:

- It is becoming increasingly costly to hire tree surgeons for regular maintenance every time the trees require trimming.
- The excessive height of these trees has become a concern for our neighbors, who have expressed their dissatisfaction with the current situation.

2. Bird Nest Assessment: A qualified tree surgeon has inspected all the trees and confirmed that there are no active bird nests. This assessment ensures that our planned works will not disrupt local wildlife.

3. Eucalyptus Tree (Tree B on the attached drawing):

There is another tree, resembling eucalyptus, whose overhanging branches are encroaching upon nearby telephone lines. We have received communication from BT (EE) emphasizing the need to cut these branches to prevent any potential hazards.

4. Proximity to the House (Trees C in the attached drawing):

Additionally, there are two to three trees on the left-hand side of the house (when viewed from Bryan Road) that are making contact with the building. The branches of these trees need to be cut back to the boundary to prevent any damage to our property.
