<p>I wish to object to planning application 2025/91370 for the proposed development of 50 houses at Gynn Lane, Honley due to serious concerns regarding road safety, infrastructure strain, and environmental harm. The access roads are narrow, lacking safe pedestrian routes, and already struggle with congestion, particularly during school drop-off and pick-up times when on-street parking reduces visibility and access, putting children and pedestrians at risk. The addition of 50 new homes would significantly worsen these issues. Furthermore, the development would result in the destruction of mature trees protected by Tree Preservation Orders and the loss of habitat for a protected rookery, breaching the Wildlife and Countryside Act 1981. These trees and the rookery are ecologically significant, and their removal would cause irreversible environmental damage. For these reasons, I strongly urge the planning authority to reject the application in its current form.</p>
