<p>There are genuine objections to this proposal well voiced by 28 people at a Holme Valley planning meeting at Honley library 30th June. A report reflecting these views has been submitted to the local authority.</p> <p>TRAFFIC</p> <p>This is a narrow lane where these houses will be built which has already been converted into a dangerous car park especially at school finishing time - do a traffic survey NOT during school holidays.</p> <p>FLOODING</p> <p>The houses around 42 and 44 Gynn Lane already experience 12 feet rises in water level during heavy rainfall the water being toxic and orange in colour.</p> <p>MINING</p> <p>There are reports produced which indicate this area is 'high risk' for building. A speaker will give details at the next meeting of concerned residents on 16th July where well over 50 very concerned local residents are expected to attend.</p> <p>NATURE</p> <p>Many trees have TPOs on them which also has hosted a rookery for forty years. The area is inhabited by badgers and roe deer.</p>
