<p>I completely object to this planning application of 50 dwellings on Gynn Lane for a number of reasons:</p> <p>1. Road infrastructure and access When the development is built there will be at least 100 additional cars adding to the traffic on Gynn Lane and Hall Ing Lane which is not wide enough at the proposed access point. There are already a lot of cars parked on the road around Honley High School drop off and pick up times, reducing visibility and increasing the risk of an accident with school children and other pedestrians.</p> <p>2. Drainage and flooding risks Building this development would remove natural soakaways to be replaced with solid foundations, roadways and other hard standings. The current highways drainage and dyke that run down Gynn Lane are already insufficient to handle high volumes of rain fall. There have already been flooding incidents at the very bottom of Gynn Lane, on Neiley Fields and the junction of Gynn Lane/New Mill Road.</p> <p>3. Wildlife and biodiversity risks The proposed development is on land that is home to a lot wildlife and no ecology report or biodiversity metric has been provided at comprehensive length.</p>
