<p>I have already logged a clear and detailed objection to this application and would request that the planning committee re read and refer to my original objections, all of which remain valid despite the revised submission. I also would also draw attention to the petition signed by a large number of residents, including myself.</p> <p>The "revised" submission fails to properly address the concerns already raised, and I would make the following additional points</p> <ol style="list-style-type: none">1. The new submission is significant in terms of volume of information. Is it reasonable that local residents only have until 12 March to review? I believe not2. The volume of disruption to Gynn Lane was already significant and the additional demolition works of a house, re alignment of Ludhill Dyke will make this even worse. The new junction configuration is already contributing to more congestion at the bottom of Gynn Lane. Construction work of the type outlined is likely to cause significant disruption and safety issues3. The traffic survey indicating that the increase in peak time journeys would only be 5 seems completely unrealistic. 50 houses, residents going to work etc. At best its naive4. The issues relating to potential flood risk, drainage, sewage (linked to the coal mining concerns) for me have not been adequately addressed. Whilst these risks remain the application should not be passed <p>I would strongly request again that this application is rejected</p>
