<p>The site for this development is completely inappropriate and dangerous, access is on a blind corner which is currently used by a single property. The road is very narrow and cars speed round the corner, this is effectively a rural country lane and totally unsuitable for such a development. In addition to this the village does not have the infrastructure to accommodate another 50 dwellings. There are also flooding issues at the bottom of Gynn Lane. When there was some testing of the area properties at the bottom of Gynn lane were flooded.</p> <p>My understanding is that the council have already approved the felling of a number of trees that were protected. This is appalling and very detrimental to wildlife. The land for development is on top of open mine shafts which could be extremely dangerous in addition to radon gas if built on. There is also a railway embankment that must not be made unstable. There are so many worrying implications for this development.</p>
