<p>I believe the planning application should be rejected for the following reasons:</p> <ol style="list-style-type: none">1. The bottom of Gynn Lane already floods on a regular basis, building on green fields adjacent to Gynn Lane can only exacerbate the existing problem;2. Destroying ancient woodland should not be permitted especially as there is an existing TPO;3. The proposed access joins Gynn Lane on a narrow blind bend which can lead to potential fatal accidents;4. School children from the new estate of 50 houses will have to cross Gynn Lane at a dangerous location;5. An additional 100+ cars will be using Gynn Lane and it is already difficult at peak times to join New Mill Road;6. The plans only show a very small area for visitors parking. When full, the visitors will park on Gynn Lane at a very narrow and again dangerous location, forcing other drivers onto the opposite side of the road where there are blind bends;7. Parking on Gynn Lane is already very difficult and congested during school drop off/pick up times and also during school events e.g. parents evenings;8. The steep access to the development is going to be very dangerous during winter conditions, this could also mean that the 100+cars will choose to park on Gynn Lane during these adverse conditions;9. School children using Gynn Lane e.g from drop offs, nearby areas will be at a higher risk of accident due to the increased traffic to/from the development including delivery vans etc.
