<p>The development seems to have found the need for expensive extra work and are trying to save money on safety issues such as removing a proposed footpath and crossing on Gynn Lane. The internal roads drains and woodland are not to be adopted and refuse collection at a single site all present potential and serious issues for the future.</p> <p>Again proposing to culvert the stream rather than bridge it increases the chances of flooding that happens at the end of Gynn Lane and the main road.</p> <p>The woodland seems not to be losing nests as over 20 can be seen being constructed at the moment.</p> <p>There is not a solution for drainage and Yorkshire water is unable to control sewer spills on to Woodroyd/Gynn lane.</p> <p>The final issue is that yet again agricultural land is being used at a time when the need for food production is increasing even on what may be marginal land.</p>
