The introduction of a large multinational chain such as Domino's into our small village of Scissett presents serious concerns that outweigh the potential benefits for our local community. Our village is proud to be home to small, independently-owned establishments, including a longstanding Italian restaurant that serves as both a community hub and a local employer. The opening of a Domino's Pizza just a short distance away threatens the survival of this business. Surrounding takeaways in villages in HD8 would undoubtedly suffer from this also. The proposed site for the Domino's takeaway is situated along one of the main arteries through the village is a further cause for concern. This road already experiences congestion during peak hours and is used by school children at Scissett Middle School and Scissett First School just meters away, cyclists, and pedestrians daily. The nature of Domino's business model—which relies heavily on delivery and rapid customer turnover—will lead to a significant increase in vehicular traffic, including mopeds and delivery cars.
