<p>Leeds Road (A62) is already a major route heavily used by commercial vehicles, including lorries and vans, throughout the day. The road infrastructure is already under pressure, and adding 51 new houses—each of which will likely generate multiple vehicles per household—would dramatically increase traffic levels. This will place an unsustainable burden on an already weak and overstretched network.</p> <p>The proposed access point is located extremely close to Alma Lane and Stubley Farm Road. Both of these junctions are already difficult and hazardous to exit due to the volume and speed of existing traffic. Adding a large number of new vehicle movements will only increase the risks, creating a dangerous situation for both drivers and the public.</p> <p>As a parent of two young children, I have very real concerns about the safety implications of this development. Leeds Road already presents risks due to the volume and speed of traffic, and any further increase will heighten the danger for children, pedestrians, and cyclists. This is not just an issue of congestion, but of public safety for the local community.</p>
