<p>I object to this application for houses to be built on this site for numerous reasons, firstly Leeds Road is extremely busy as it is and an additional 100 plus vehicles will only make it worse. The junction from Alma lane and Stubble Farm Lane are hazardous to navigate at busy times and pulling onto our drive is difficult especially when vehicles run the lights and are speeding.</p> <p>Secondly is the concern of flooding which happens yearly with heavy rain due to the clay bed under the fields, from viewing the plans submitted a sewage pump station for the dwelling will be behind our fence at top of the garden. If this is ever damaged or fails it will inevitably end up on our property. These pumping stations all make a noise which is not acceptable, we bought this property with the idea nothing could ever be built on green belt land and obviously not correct when this can be changed to brown belt on a whim without any consultation.</p> <p>These are just a couple of the reasons but I must also mention the bat population, wildlife, trees and overall disruption in having a road just a few metres from our property.</p>
