Hi Mr. Royston,

Having reviewed the evidence which you have submitted with your email, we will approve the removal and replacement of 22.1 in this case under a 5 day notice due to the presence of *Kretzchmaria*, evidence of decay, and the location of the tree adjacent to the footpath and neighbouring properties.

For the reasons already expressed, I would not support the 5m crown lifting and 20% crown reduction. You have submitted an appeal, and we will await the determination. In the meantime, you are welcome to apply for lesser works.

On the most recent visit to the site on the 16th of April 2025, 4 trees of relevant species were found to have been planted. Two were dead (1X beech and 1X horse chestnut) and the two remaining, living stems are new beech trees located on the frontage of Oxford Road. Please submit evidence of the tree planting that you state has been carried out.

The replanting must be carried out in accordance with the relevant Decision Notices (attached for your convenience). For tree locations please refer to the Tree Constraints plans shown within your reports: 160525, 160525a, 160525c and 160525f. For the tree locations relating to the application 2012/90663 please refer to the tree location plan submitted with the application.

In respect to your comments regarding dangerous and hazardous branches in trees T2, T5, T13, G19, G22, I am not aware of this. Please provide more information and I will review this.
