Dear Sir/Madam,

We wish to object to the planning application 2025/91688: Erection of single storey side extension at 21 High Close, Linthwaite, Huddersfield, HD7 5ST, on the following grounds.

1. Adequate space and parking for construction work is crucial for safety and efficiency. There is not enough adequate space/parking for these works to be carried out. 21 High Close is positioned at the very top of a cul-de-sac, and we are very concerned as to where:

Tradesmen, trailers, diggers, materials being delivered, skips, workmen/builders and the home owners own vehicles are going to park and unload materials without blocking access, to and from, our private garage (with drop kerb) and also our private drive (with drop kerb).

2. This planning application will significantly impact our garden, due to the dust and debris created by the election of the side extension at 21 High Close. The dust and debris will negatively affect our garden and our ability to use it because:

2a. We have an outside aviary, which is very close to the where the extension at 21 High Close will be. The dust and debris can be harmful to birds in an outside aviary. The dust can irritate their respiratory system, potentially leading to breathing difficulties. Construction activities can create significant amounts of dust and particulates (even without toxic materials), posing a risk to birds. The combination of dust and noise from construction can also cause stress and disturbance to birds, potentially affecting their behaviour and well-being.

2b. We have a fish pond too. Dust and debris from construction can negatively impact our fish and water quality in our pond. Construction materials and particles (e.g. cement dust, stihl saw dust)

can contaminate the water, potentially harming fish by damaging their gills and affecting the water quality.

2c. We pride ourselves on keeping a beautiful garden. Dust and debris from construction can negatively impact our plants and flowers. Dust can hinder photosynthesis, reduce water absorption, and potentially introduce harmful chemicals, leading to reduced growth, weakened plant health, and even plant death.

2d. Dust and debris will dramatically reduce and affect our enjoyment of using our garden and even our conservatory. Construction work on the side extension of 21 High Close is very close to our conservatory. This work will create a lot of dust and debris that can settle on surfaces inside and outside of our home and affect air quality.

We would be grateful for the planning authorities take our objections into serious consideration when making their decision.
