<p>This is a retrospective application because the original applications details has not been adhered to .The current building and driveway and landscaping does not conform to the type of agricultural building which this purports to be .</p> <p>The building techniques and finish is not what was planned for example it has double breeze block walls from floor to ceiling .There has been extensive groundwork's ,in originally green belt land , to form retaining gabion walls and hard surfaces.</p> <p>This detracts massively from the natural environment in this elevated rural location .As one looks across from Holme and Digley reservoir road it stands out as completely at odds with other buildings around it .This landscape on the edge of the Peak District is negatively effected by its industrial appearance.</p> <p>Currently the building is a garage for a variety of cars .</p> <p>The retrospective application mentioned that it was for a "residential building " this may have been an error but it is indicative of the lack of regard for planning law .</p> <p>I do feel that this development is completely at odds with this village environment and I feel the area should be protected by the council for future generations by refusing this type of large obtrusive construction .</p>
