Good morning, I recently went to assess a mature goat willow at 39 St Helens gate, Almondbury HD4 6SD. The tree is located in the rear garden within the conservation area.

Recently two limbs have failed (see attached pictures) leaving the canopy unbalanced and over extended limbs exposed. The tree either needs to be removed or pollarded to reduce the risk of failure onto public/property and I am requesting a 5 day notice to carry out this work. I do believe the tree is a high risk due to reduced structural integrity of the stems.
