Onsite habitats and species

The site appears to have habitats (trees, building, grassland) which would be suitable for a number of species; including bats, birds, and hedgehogs.

Further information is required prior to decision. Several records for protected and priority species and habitats are present within 1km of the site. A Preliminary Ecological Appraisal is therefore required prior to decision to assess the site habitats, the likely presence of protected and/or priority species, and the value of site habitats to protected and/or priority species.

Reason: *In the interests of biodiversity and in accordance with LP30 and NPPF15.*

BNG

The site is 265m² in size and so BNG would be applicable. A BNG assessment, statutory metric and plan to achieve 10% is required for this application, as set out in Schedule 7A of the Town and Country Planning Act 1990 (as amended).
