<p>As per my objections on previous versions of this application: Living on the hill, we witness regular excessive speeding of vehicles and accidents not reported in the transport review. We have seen three - two neighbouring walls and one Lampost run into within 10m of the proposed entrance within the last 5 years. The lampost remained damaged for years. Why are these omitted? The land is extremely waterlogged, building will lead to further property damage to low laying land which is public access and use. Further walkways and greenspace have been removed from access by the village. Particularly in the last 2 years, most usable public space is gone, this is one of the sole areas and pathways. The land is home to owls displaced when trees were removed from further up cockley hill in 2020. To which the council took no action, despite removal in nesting season. The local services cannot cope - my child's class has 35 kids, too many for KS1 already. We can't see anything like a local or regular doctor and didn't for many years. Services like the library are always at risk and the local transport routes are a joke. For most of the last 3 months the main access from the village to the m1 has been shut for extended waterworks. Finally our properties won't survive construction vehicles, for that reason they have not been allowed to access this very road. Build on the brownfields. Leave the greenfields green.</p>
