The application as per my pre-application (your reference 2025/20666) is for the addition of an extension to the rear of my property. This is to allow a garden space at the first level whilst retaining the existing parking available on the ground floor for 2 x vehicles. This is then accessible from the first floor via bi-folding door from the living room area. Careful consideration has been made to minimise impact at all levels, and hence the choice to use a locally favourable building material in oak for the frame and deck. This has also been discussed with the neighbours on the street to address any concerns and their input forming the design/dimensions/layout of the proposal. As per the pre planning advice, if required and requested a privacy screen will be installed as to now allow any impact on the neighbouring properties (however at discussion above with them this was not requested, but fully able to be implemented at any later date.
