<p>I am writing to object to the proposed changes to Shops 2 and 3, which would allow them to be used as a nursery/daycare and include alterations to the building layout.</p> <p>Work has already begun, and on the Sunday the 31st August, paint from an open gap in the wall—where I believe a new window is planned at the back—was blown into my garden. This caused damage to my clothes on the washing line, my garden furniture, and the fruit and vegetables I'm growing. The gap is still uncovered, and I'm concerned that if this application is approved, further damage will occur, especially with stronger winds and more construction activity.</p> <p>I'm also worried about the new windows facing directly on to my property, which will affect my privacy. The proposed outdoor play area may bring additional noise and disturbance during the day, which will impact my ability to enjoy my home and garden peacefully.</p> <p>In addition, I believe that opening another nursery in this location could negatively affect existing childcare providers in the area. There are already nurseries nearby that have been serving local families for years, and introducing a new one so close could take away business from them and put their future at risk.</p> <p>I have taken photos of the damage to my garden and belongings, which I am happy to provide as evidence.</p> <p>I ask that you please take these concerns seriously and do not approve the proposed changes in their current form.</p> <p>I hope you take into consideration the concerns of local residents.</p>
