<p>One of my main worries is the new windows being added — they directly overlook my home and garden, which affects my privacy. I've lived here for over 30 years and have always valued the peace and privacy of my space.</p> <p>I'm also concerned about a door that's been fitted above the old toilet block. It leads onto a flat roof that looks straight over my garden and several others. I'd really like to know what the purpose of that door is and whether it's going to be used as access or some kind of outdoor area. They're also proposing a fenced-off area at the front of the building, which would be right next to a very busy road. Traffic on that stretch is already slow-moving and congested during school and work run times, and I don't see anything in place to manage the flow or improve safety.</p> <p>The plan to turn part of the building into a nursery is also a concern. There are already a number of nurseries in the area, and adding another one could increase noise, parking issues, and traffic problems on an already busy street.</p> <p>Lastly, even though work has already started, it hasn't gone smoothly — my neighbour has had their property damaged by paint or sprayed materials coming from the site. That's not acceptable and raises concerns about how future work will be handled.</p> <p>I'd be grateful if all these points could be considered before any decisions are made.</p>
