Please see below my responses to your questions in your email.

Please find attached a heritage statement for the application. I note in the Golcar conservation appraisal the application property is incorrectly identified (coloured) as "an early 19th century weavers cottage" which it is not. From my research, the property was constructed in the period of 1941-1948 when it first appeared on local maps.

The porch is a replacement of the dilapidated existing porch constructed prior to the applicant's ownership of the property and outside of the application as is/was under construction during my survey.

Please find attached a completed climate change statement for the application. I also note this template appears to be more geared for new build and larger scale applications. Given the very small nature of the application and the existing construction of the property, there is very little that can be achieved from the guidance.
