I am making this objection as I believe the plans for five houses on this site is utterly excessive, especially as previous plans for the site have been turned down. Visually, the five houses look like a little estate, totally out of character for the rural land and area that is Lumb Lane. Houses already standing in Lumb Lane go back to the 19th century and recent planning for the redevelopment of bungalows along Lumb Lane towards Sharp Lane consider this. The plans for this particular plot do not. Woodsome valley is one of the last areas of natural beauty in a gone-to-seed Kirklees and should be maintained for the wildlife: birds, foxes, deer and particularly the badgers. Lumb Lane is narrow - most of the cottages along from this proposed site are without garages hence need on-road parking. This already causes problems. There has already been damage to residents' cars as other traffic tries to manoeuvre through. Traffic from building five extra houses - diggers, truck deliveries, service vehicles will only add to the misery and frustration of residents.
