<p>My original objection to the building application for 5 new houses remains the same for the now newly revised application for 4 new houses.</p> <p>See my original objection below;</p> <p>I am objecting to the proposed building of 5 new dwellings on Lumb Lane. From looking at the proposed location it seems to me that only a small area is made up of greenhouses and a single storey shed, and a large proportion of the area is made up of established trees, a pond and grass. This surely is agricultural land and not Greybelt or Brownbelt and should be returned to its original state. I don't think the new houses would be in-keeping with the surrounding properties, area or landscape. It appears to me that it would have an adverse effect on the properties nearby. On July 3rd whilst out walking with my daughter on Lumb Lane, I came across a dead badger lying on the roadside. The Whatthreewords location of the badger is: ///flash.filer.discouraged. My daughter contacted &quot;The Huddersfield Badger Group&quot; (I include the telephone number: 07508813411) to inform them. The woman my daughter spoke to had already received a number of calls relating to the black and white striped, stout, medium-sized mammal that day.
