<p>In light of the amendments to the original planning application, my previous objection still stands. I would like to reiterate some of my points and add to my objection.</p> <p>Since I first raised my objection, I've noticed several new wild birds in the area of the proposed development, including Redwing, Siskin, Lesser black-backed Gull, Red Grouse, and Stonechat. These birds are native to the Woodsome Valley, which is a protected area of historical significance and natural beauty.</p> <p>The proposed development would have a detrimental impact on the greenbelt and the surrounding area. It would destroy green spaces in historically important landscapes, which are integral to the protected Woodsome Valley's rural setting.</p> <p>Huddersfield has many Brownfield sites that need regeneration, which should be the focus of development rather than destroying green spaces in historically important landscapes.</p> <p>Removing the polytunnels and allowing the land to revert to grazing or agricultural use would be a more beneficial solution.</p> <p>This isn't about being anti-housing; it's about building homes in the right places. Developers need to respect this principle.</p>
