I wish to object to the proposal regarding the above application on the following grounds.

A reduction in the number of stalls will impact the business viability of the venue and the traders using the market.

Events that use the market, such as the Auto Jumble, would no longer be able to operate from the market with a reduced number of stalls.

The current number of stalls provides traders with the ability to increase their presence within the market; any reduction would impact this flexibility.

Please do reconsider the views of traders and those like me who enjoy visiting Huddersfield and the Auto Jumble.

The market hall is a jewel in the centre of Huddersfield, and any reduction in footfall into the town would be a travesty.

Reducing the number of stalls would be a detrimental move; be creative, go back to the drawing board and keep the current number of stalls.

Across the country, town centres are becoming "ghost towns"; however, the Sunday Auto Jumble bucks this trend and allows the council to showcase how to regenerate town centres.
