I am writing to formally object to the above planning applications.

I am a helper at the Autojumble help regularly in the building.

While the market could certainly benefit from some general maintenance, such as a fresh coat of paint, there is nothing fundamentally wrong with it.

The building is a **listed structure of significant historic value**, and any redevelopment should prioritise preserving both its character and its cultural purpose. In my view, this proposal does neither. It threatens to undermine both the heritage of the building and the unique community use it has served for generations. The Auto Jumble would be unable to continue with the proposed loss of stalls, etc. It has recently lost stalls to the fruit and veg man for no understandable reason.

I therefore **urge the planning committee to reject this application** and instead properly maintain it for the future of the community, stallholders and customers.
