Subject: Objection - changes to Huddersfield market

To whom it may concern

Please take this as a strong objection to the planned changes to Huddersfield market.

The market provides a livelihood to many and a reason for people to come into town from both local and further afield. The autojumble is a great example of this as is Saturdays morning market; both of which I have attended for 10+ years every single week (and every month in the case of the jumble).

For what it's worth, I think the market brings people into town from my side of HD8 who would otherwise go into Wakefield or Barnsley. The market brings in many other vintage collectors from Leeds, Bradford and York. I see them every week and we compare our finds; it then leads to grabbing the week's shop at Tesco and any other bits needed in town.

Making the market unfeasible for the autojumble for example would genuinely cause hardship to some of the traders who rely on that space. I don't doubt Saturday market traders would say the same.

Please rethink this decision. Too many livelihoods depend on our market.
