My name is _____, and I have assisted at the Autojumble held within the market building on a regular basis.

The Huddersfield Open Market is a listed structure of significant historical and cultural value. Any redevelopment should therefore prioritise the preservation of both its architectural character and its long-standing community location. The current proposals fail to do so and instead risk undermining the building's heritage and the unique role it has fulfilled for generations.

In particular, the proposed reduction in stalls would make it impossible for the Autojumble to continue operating, and would disappoint and alienate many stallholders and customers who come into the area to spend money ... and have a good old motoring chat.

For these reasons, I respectfully urge the Planning Committee to reject the proposed applications. I ask that the Council instead consider a programme of appropriate maintenance and repair to secure the market's future for the benefit of the community, stallholders, and customers alike.
