Q1: What measures have been/will be taken to reduce the energy demand associated with your proposed development beyond the minimum required in Building Regulations? (See section 2)
The extension would be completed to a minimum Building Regulations compliance standard. All mechanical and electrical elements of the installation would be installed to current standards.

All materials and labour would be sourced from local contractors and sub-contractors.

As this is an existing residential dwelling, there are no intentions to exceed the requirements of Part L of the Building Regulations.
