We the below signed would like to register our support for all aspects of the above referenced planning application.

With regards to the bay windows, these were not part of the original structure of the building but were added in the late 1980's. These windows are combustible and have no 'fire stopping'. The structures have also been badly maintained and are now in a dangerous state. The below signed would like these bay windows removed and replaced with a flat window.

With regards the wooden structures which form the main entrances to the flats 100 - 102a and 116 - 132, these have also been badly maintained and are also in a dangerous state. We look forward to them being replaced.

In a survey carried out 2/12/2020 by Thomasons it was pointed out both the bay windows and wood forming the entrances to flats should be removed and replaced with 'non-combustible' materials.

We hope this will be dealt with quickly as we are anxious for the works to start quickly.
