Worker vehicles took up all of the space on Moor Lane and when you could park, the one way traffic lights made parking incredibly dangerous. Our vehicles were completely covered in dust for 3 weeks as builders worked to rebuild the walls. If this is the tip of the ice berg I dread to think of the inconvenience that this building work will cause for local residents. Increased worker presence will mean parking anywhere near your home impossible or there will be fear of moving your vehicle as you wont be able to park when you return. Road safety has been mentioned before. The volume of traffic is already substantial which will be made worse when another junction is added with 20 or so cars going in and out. The space intended for building is full of local wildlife and this site will kill the wildlife living there. The amount of trees that will be destroyed is disgusting.
