In a supporting document for Application number 2025/61/92713/E Supporting Information [id 1108683] Ecological Design Strategy Report at: Land off Moor Lane, Cleckheaton, West Yorkshire, BD19 4LF. JCA Ref: 23091a/GB supplied by JCA Ltd., Arboricultural & Ecological Consultant.

On Page 18 of this document it states:

“6.1.3 Note: Special attention should be made to ensure that no light spill falls upon any of the trees within Ings Grove Park that is directly adjacent to the site, either pre- or post-development.

6.1.4 Proposed dark corridors containing all bat bricks and boxes, and connecting the site to Ings Grove Park can be seen in Appendix 3.”

These points make reference to an address, Ings Grove Park, which is not located in this area that this planning application covers. The nearest destination I can find for this address is 6 miles away in Mirfield.

If this document is making reference to an area/address outside which this planning application covers, this brings into question how accurate all the other information contained in this document is. It may be quoting incorrect facts throughout the document that are not relevant to this site and planning application.

How can the information in this document be confidently relied upon as accurate justification and supporting evidence for this planning application?
