I am writing to object to the planning application for the above application and to air my concerns in relation to the safety of my children.

I live at number 29 Moor Lane and apart from the disruption the building will cause and the lack of privacy from having these houses, I'm writing to you today because I am concerned about the safety . On the documents the splays that are shown demonstrate visibility down the street past my house however the diagram doesn't have my hedges on that line my front garden and you cannot see through them as the diagram suggests. Moor lane is a very busy road and it's hard to pull out of my driveway and for to cross the road as it is. If the cars pulling out of the new proposed development cannot see down the road due to the hedges in my front garden how will they see crossing the road?

I have highlighted this more than once when planning permission has been open to comments, I have emailed my local councillor and this has not been addressed. The plans submitted have always shown the same plan, that you can see down the road which is incorrect.

I am extremely concerned that this will be overlooked and that safety is low down the list of priorities when it comes to planning for these houses and I'm emailing you today to seeks some reassurance that this will be rectified and addressed. I have attached the plans with where my bushes are and pictures of the hedge to show how obstructive they are. I have no intention of removing my bushes as they are there for privacy due to house across the road.
